Residents' Information:

Isle of Dogs

The 45th annual edition of the London Marathon takes place on Sunday 27 April 2025 and will require road closures and parking restrictions in your area.

More than 50,000 participants will take on the 26.2-mile course, which starts in Greenwich, crosses Tower Bridge and travels through the Isle of Dogs before finishing on The Mall in Westminster.

This leaflet provides specific access details for Isle of Dogs residents.

To enter

If you need to drive onto the Isle of Dogs between 08:00 and 20:30 on Sunday 27 April, please use the A13 East India Dock Road, Leamouth Road to Leamouth Roundabout, and take Blackwall Way to access Prestons Road.

Please note: the existing bus-only section of Blackwall Way will be suspended from 08:00 to 20:30 on Sunday 27 April to allow access to the Isle of Dogs.

To exit

If you need to drive off of the Isle of Dogs between 08:00 and 20:30 on Sunday 27 April, please use Yabsley Street, Blackwall Way, and Leamouth Roundabout to access the A13 East India Dock Road.

Parking restrictions

Any vehicles parked on the route will be removed from 04:00 on Sunday 27 April. Please assist us by moving your vehicle off the route on the evening of Saturday 26 April. If your vehicle is relocated by event contractors, please visit **trace.london** to find it.
