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
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
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Let's get all of your children moving and see if they can complete two miles in their setting anytime between **Monday 23 February** and **Friday 1 May**.



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Thank you for signing up for the TCS Mini London Marathon in schools. Here's a message from Peppa Pig.




Hello!






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GET ACTIVE AT HOME WITH PEPPA PIG: DIARY LOG SHEET


We're taking part in the TCS Mini London Marathon in schools two-mile challenge between the 23 February and 1 May 2026, with a little help from Peppa Pig.




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SET 1

How many different sporting events can you think of?


What makes sporting events fun?




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EVENT PLANNING WITH PEPPA PIG: ACTIVE MAP


Training and event routes need to be planned otherwise they can turn out quite wacky!

What will you put on your active map?





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



Let's prepare to celebrate your two-mile achievement.




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EVENT PLANNING WITH PEPPA PIG: BATON DESIGN
