The TCS London Marathon returns on Sunday 26 April 2026

For safety reasons, due to the increased number of spectators at the event, it is necessary to close **Queen Anne's Gate** between Broadway and the entrance to St James's Park on Sunday 26 April.

To reduce disruption Queen Anne's Gate will close, as and when required, between 11:00 and 18:00 to help safely manage spectator movements. Please see the map over the page for details.

Parking will be available at Queen Anne's Gate as usual and the road will remain accessible throughout the day from Carteret Street and Dartmouth Street.
