# Canary Wharf

**The 46th annual edition of the London Marathon takes place on Sunday 26 April 2026 and will require road closures and parking restrictions in your area.**

More than 50,000 participants will take on the 26.2-mile course, which starts in Greenwich, crosses Tower Bridge and travels through Canary Wharf before finishing on The Mall in Westminster.

## **Road closures**

So the event can go ahead safely, roads will be closed in Canary Wharf from 08:00 to 20:30 on Sunday 26 April 2026.

The course will use several different roads in Canary Wharf, including Montgomery Street, Water Street and Charter Street. Please see the map of the route over the page.

This year there will be an extended closure within a small section of Canary Wharf, between 06:00 and 08:00 on Sunday 26 April, to allow for infrastructure to be installed.

This will impact eastbound traffic on North Colonnade between Westferry Circus and Upper Bank Street and northbound traffic on Upper Bank Street between South Colonnade and Aspen Way.

Access to buildings on North Colonnade will be facilitated during this time.

## **Parking restrictions**

Any vehicles parked on the route will be removed from 04:00 on Sunday 26 April.

Please assist us by moving your vehicle off the route on the evening of Saturday 25 April. If your vehicle is relocated by event contractors, please visit [trace.london](https://www.trace.london) to find it.

## **Open as usual**

Shops and transport links will be open as usual, but we recommend all residents and businesses plan ahead to minimise any potential disruption.
