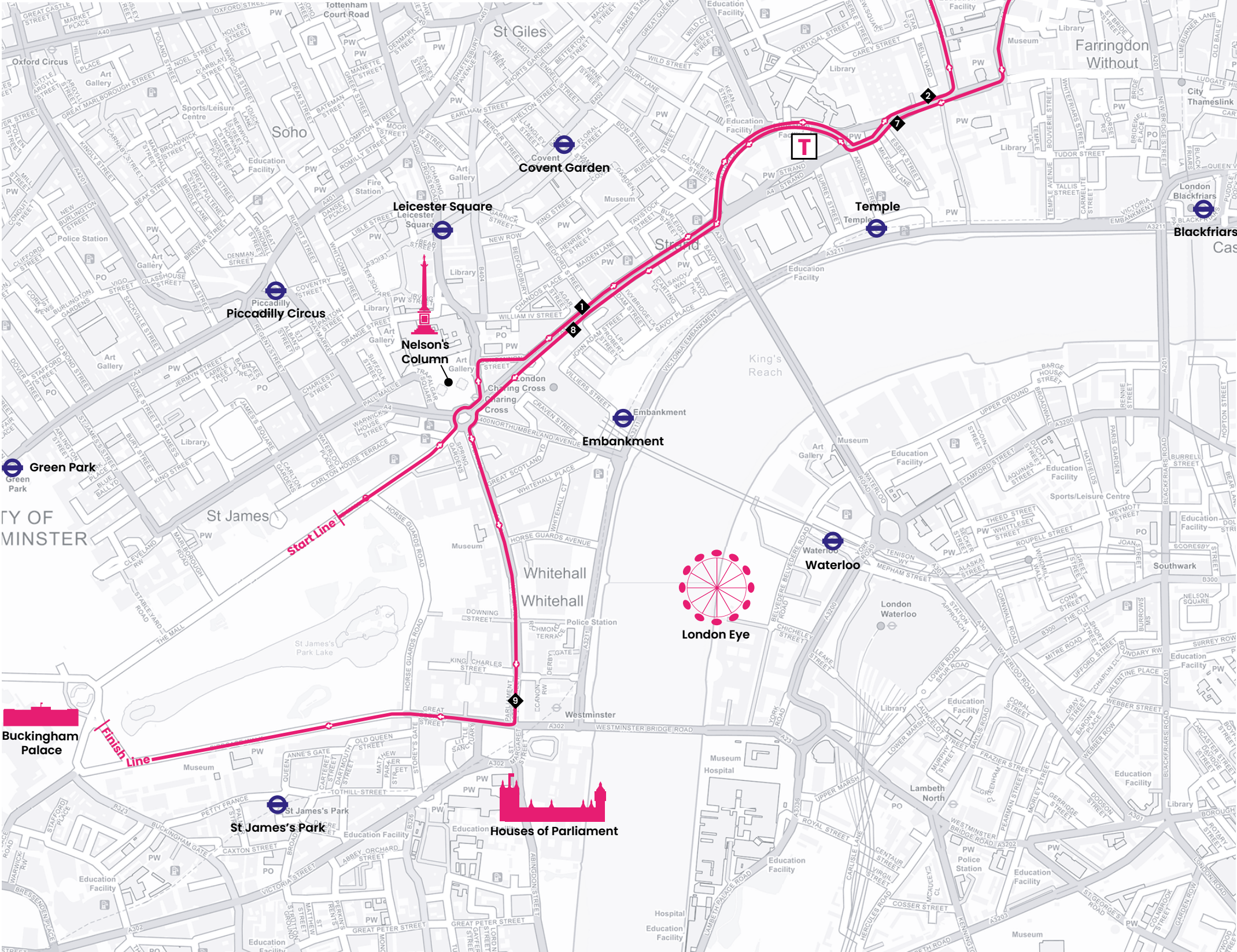
Road closures on Friday 25, Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 September

Road closures will be in operation in central London on Friday 25, Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 September 2026 as part of the Vitality Westminster Mile and the Vitality London 10,000.

The closures will affect the City of Westminster, City of London and the London Borough of Camden.

On Saturday 26 September the Vitality Westminster Mile, a series of family-friendly fun runs, will take place on closed roads around St James's Park. The map on the back page of this leaflet shows which roads will be closed.

On Sunday 27 September the Vitality London 10,000 will take place on the closed roads displayed in pink on this page.

Resident access routes
On Sunday 27 September, residents encircled by the road closures on Chancery Lane, Holborn and New Fetter Lane can exit the area using the following vehicle access routes:

- Southampton Buildings to Holborn eastbound carriageway
- Furnal Street to Brooke Street or Holborn eastbound carriageway

Residents on St Andrew Street, Shoe Lane and surrounding areas will be able to enter and exit via Shoe Lane and Charterhouse Street.

Residents of Little Britain and Bartholomew Close can enter and exit the area via Rotunda (Museum of London).

Access will be facilitated by stewards only when it is safe to do so. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Safe and secure
Emergency vehicles will be treated as a priority in the usual way throughout the events.

Police officers and stewards will be present during both events to help answer your queries, ensuring a safe and secure weekend for everyone.
